Introduction

As the Food Bank+ moves in to another year we are overwhelmed by the kindness and generosity of our community throughout such a difficult and challenging time. Over the last year we helped feed 2,432 people who could not afford to buy food and we could not do this vital work in the community without you.

The last year has seen the Food Bank continue to grow and we have expanded our team and services due to an increase in demand. We have also added to our storage and we now have a large storage container.

We have grown our CMA (Community Money Advice) team and have our own dedicated office 'The Lighthouse'. This is such a blessing and we are committed to continuing to develop this service by helping people managing their money.

Christmas Restored

Following an accident and awaiting back surgery Mark* was unable to work and not receiving any benefits. As a carer for one of their children, his wife was in receipt of Carer's Allowance. However, this was not enough to pay all the bills and feed their young family.

Mark contacted us and we immediately provided a large food parcel full of fresh food, a Cook (recipe) Bag, and treats for everyone. We also referred him to the Children's Centre for further support.

School shoe vouchers and clothing for their children were supplied and we continued to provide regular food parcels. Two Acts435 applications were submitted to fund new bathroom flooring, clothing and shoes for Mark.

At Christmas the family received a luxury Christmas hamper and a local gift shop gave the children a bag each

full of Christmas presents. They also visited our Santa's Grotto and Dorset Council provided pantomime tickets for the family. Mark said:

"Thank you for all the support and kindness... We have been really anxious with Christmas approaching... bracing ourselves to tell them [the children] unfortunately that they had to miss out on Christmas this year.

Your help means that our babies will have presents to open on Christmas Day. The excitement that our two boys had when told that they were going to see Father Christmas... was absolutely magical, they continually re-live the evening with each other. Reinforcing their positive memories of Christmas. Something that without your help and generosity would have never been possible. Thank you." *Name changed to protect identity

"Christmas isn't a very nice time, my anxiety goes up tenfold... I have the worst memories and the children had such an awful past that I'm forever trying to make it up to them...It's even harder at Christmas...

Faithworks CMA

Our CMA (Community Money Advice) team provide free debt advice and budget support. We are part of the national CMA network which means we are able to function as debt advisors, compliant and regulated by the FCA (Financial Conduct Authority).

We also work closely with local agencies including: Citizens Advice, Shelter, Dorset Council and CAP (Christians Against Poverty).

Acts 435



An online giving charity, directly connecting those who want to give with those who are in genuine need. Acts 435 has provided an invaluable resource to source funding for a wide variety of critical needs such as beds, bedding and clothing. We submitted 77 applications for Acts 435 grants over the last year.

One single Mum and her three children had moved on from the women's refuge however, were unable to afford all the furniture they needed for their new home. An Acts 435

grant application was made to fund a bed, wardrobe and a bed and bedding for the toddler.

We also provided regular food parcels, school uniforms and referred the Mum to the Wardrobe Foundation for a clothing pack. Over Christmas they visited our Christmas grotto and received one of our luxury hampers and free pantomime tickets (donated by Wimborne Minster Town Council) and children's gift bags from the Present Company.

"Thank you so much to the generous individuals who donated towards my children's school uniform.

It's been a tough year but the kindness of some people shines bright enough to make it worthwhile. I've been able to get my children school clothes for at least a year.



Our incredible volunteers gave 3,640 hours in time last year!

Our amazing team is made up of forty-six wonderful volunteers and two paid part-time staff. The volunteers perform various roles such as rotating stock, making food parcels, serving clients, collecting donations and fresh food from supermarkets, delivering food parcels and providing money advice.

Recipe Bags

Our Recipe Bags have been extremely popular! The bags include recipe of the week and all the ingredients required to make the sweet or savoury dish. Recipes have included pancakes for Shrove Tuesday, fish cakes, macaroni cheese and pineapple upside down cake.

This initiative creates the opportunity for families to cook together, increasing confidence in children to try new ingredients and recipes, as well as practice new skills in the kitchen. We think that families who cook together are also more likely to eat together.

"You gave us breathing space to reduce our stress levels and not to worry about feeding our children.

So Much More Than Food...

We believe everyone should have access to food. We also understand that people need more than food to enable them to live well.

In addition to our CMA Debt Advice Service, food parcels and school holiday parcels, we provide a large bag of fresh fruit, vegetables, bread, feminine hygiene products, baby food, nappies, toiletries, cleaning products and cat or dog food. We also provide Recipe Bags with all the ingredients and the recipe to make a fresh sweet or savoury dish.

Thanks to a grant from the Friends of Canford School we were able to give every child an outdoor game over the summer school holiday period.

Last Christmas we held our very first Christmas Grotto where families were given the chance to meet Father Christmas, choose their own Christmas present and pick and wrap a gift for their parents. It was a very emotional and festive event. We are already planning our next one!

"Wimborne Food [Bank+] has been a Godsend to me. Not being able to afford the most important things like food is not just hard but destroying...

My first time coming to the food bank I could not stop crying, I was embarrassed, scared and had a panic attack. The most amazing people there helped me... and not just with food, there was Christmas presents, clothes, toiletries, laundry stuff, finance advice and an ear to listen.
