

How to apply for your free Will

You can go to any Will provider to make a Will and leave a gift to us. If you don't know where to start, would prefer to see someone locally, or would love a free Will, then we have teamed up with local solicitor Coles Miller, who can provide a Will, and Faithworks will then cover the cost.*

To apply for your free Will contact Coles Miller by phoning 01202 338888 or write to Coles Miller Solicitors LLP of Harbour House, Marshes End, Upton Road, Poole BH17 7AG. Explain that you want to make an appointment under the Faithworks Free Wills Service.

Once you have made your Will, you will be asked to complete the form (overleaf) which will be returned to us by Coles Miller. This will enable us to measure how effective the service is.



*Terms and conditions

- You (or your partner for a joint Will) must be over 50 to take part.
- Faithworks will cover the cost of a standard Will up to a maximum agreed limit. Non-standard Wills may incur a top-up fee which you will be required to pay – Coles Miller can advise on this when booking.
- In order for us to cover the cost of your Will, you must complete, sign and date the Free Wills Participants Form (overleaf). Coles Miller will return this form to us with the invoice for the costs incurred which you also need to sign and date.
- We will keep your details in line with GDPR.
- Faithworks reserves the right to withdraw this offer at any time.



Why Leave a Gift to Faithworks?

Our work saves lives. That’s what individuals say to us! We provide practical support at the point of crisis to literally thousands of people. We have the determination to be there for the “one” family or individual, fighting for them to get debt free, or get into a home, or simply rebuild a supportive community. The money to do this only comes from grants and donations – your gifts make it possible for us to be there for another... and another...

What Difference Will My Gift Make?

Your gift enables us to expand our crucial services for those battling financial or food poverty, lone parenting or homelessness. This might include a community meal, or a trainee opportunity for those moving on from homelessness. A gift could fund a new van to transport essential food or furniture, or it could pay for new team members to expand our projects.

Here’s how your legacy could help:

- £4,000 will pay for the SMILE Lone Parent Fair and summer activities for lone parent families for a year.
- £25,000 will help to provide secure accommodation for a homeless family or 3 individuals.
- £100,000 will fund our core debt advice service for 2 years, helping lift 50 households out of debt and into financial resilience.

You can be as specific as you wish about how we use your donation. Although it is most helpful if a donation is left open for us to use where the need is greatest, we appreciate that you may wish to support specific projects. Either way, your wishes will be fully respected.

There are three main types of legacy gift:

1. Residuary Gift:
a percentage of your estate after expenses have been covered.

2. Pecuniary Gift:
a specific sum of money - this can be index linked to maintain its value.

3. Specific Legacy:
a non-cash gift such as property, shares or a personal item of value.
